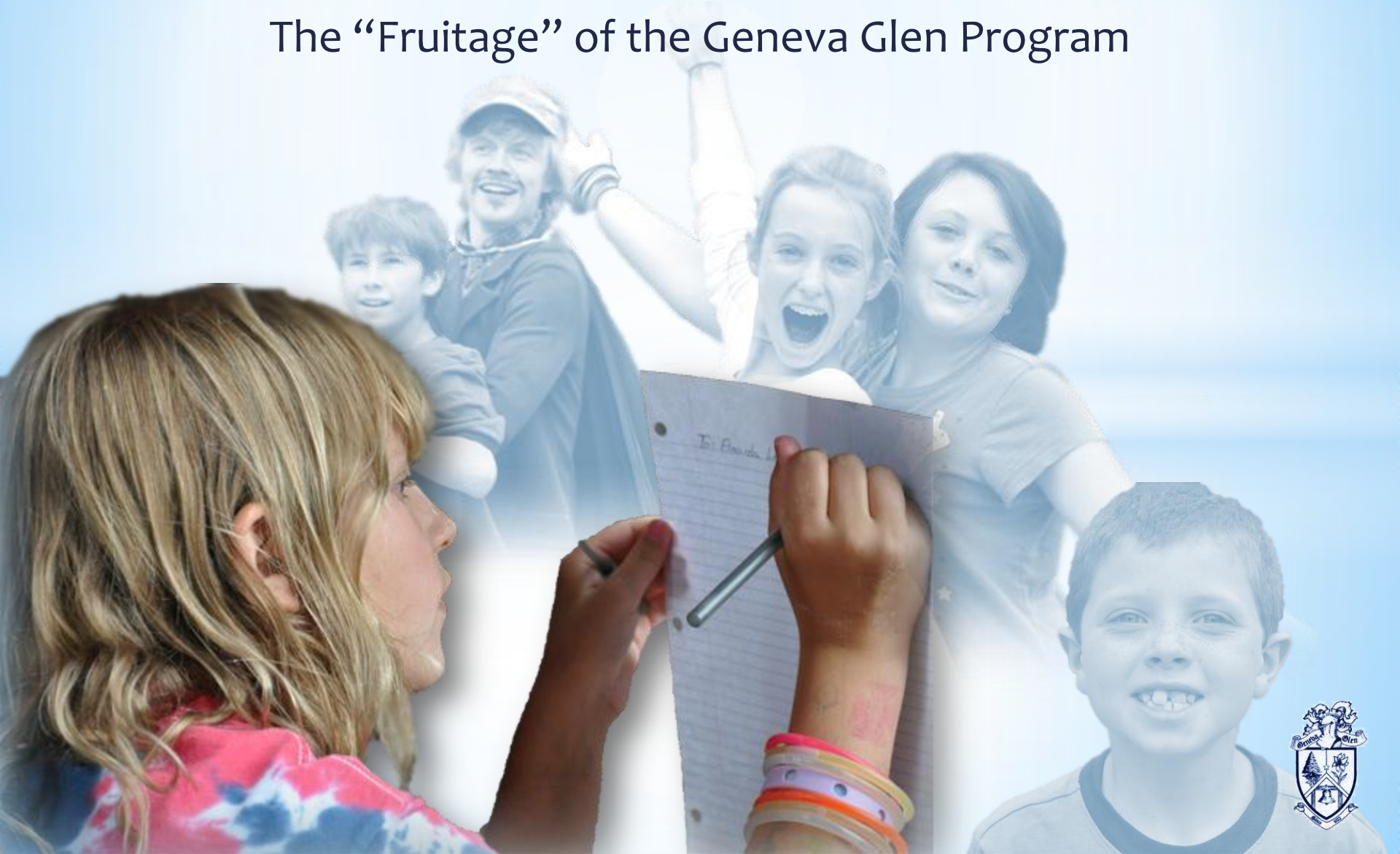
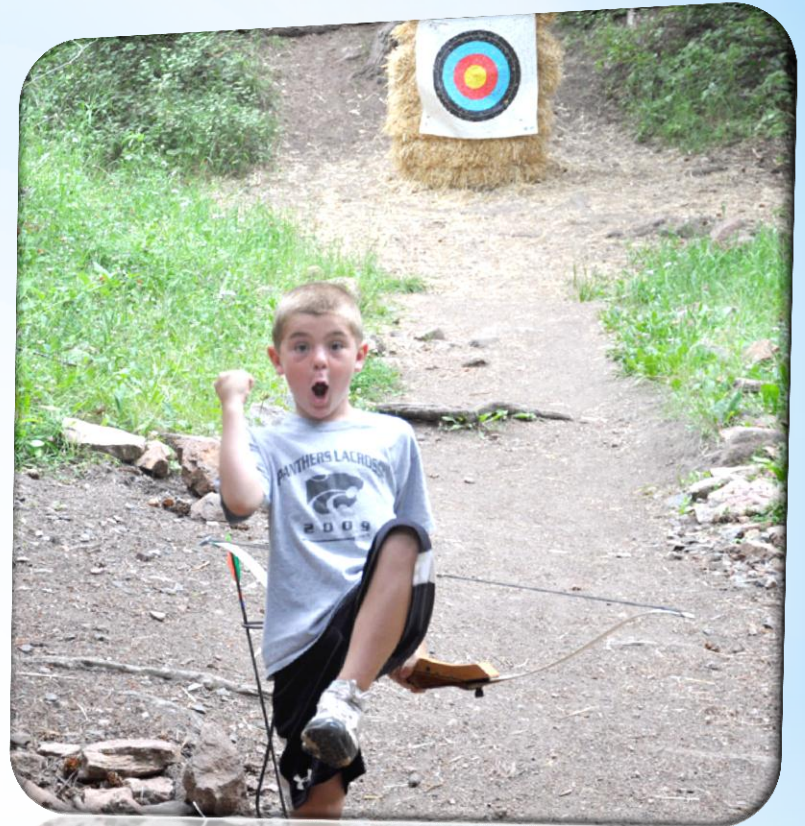


Youth Outcomes 2010

The “Fruitage” of the Geneva Glen Program



- * Grades 2 - 5
- * 14 Question oral survey to measure broad “camp learning” based on the first 7 outcomes
- * Uses an easy, four-point Likert scale
- * 55 Campers were interviewed representing approximately 20% of that demographic

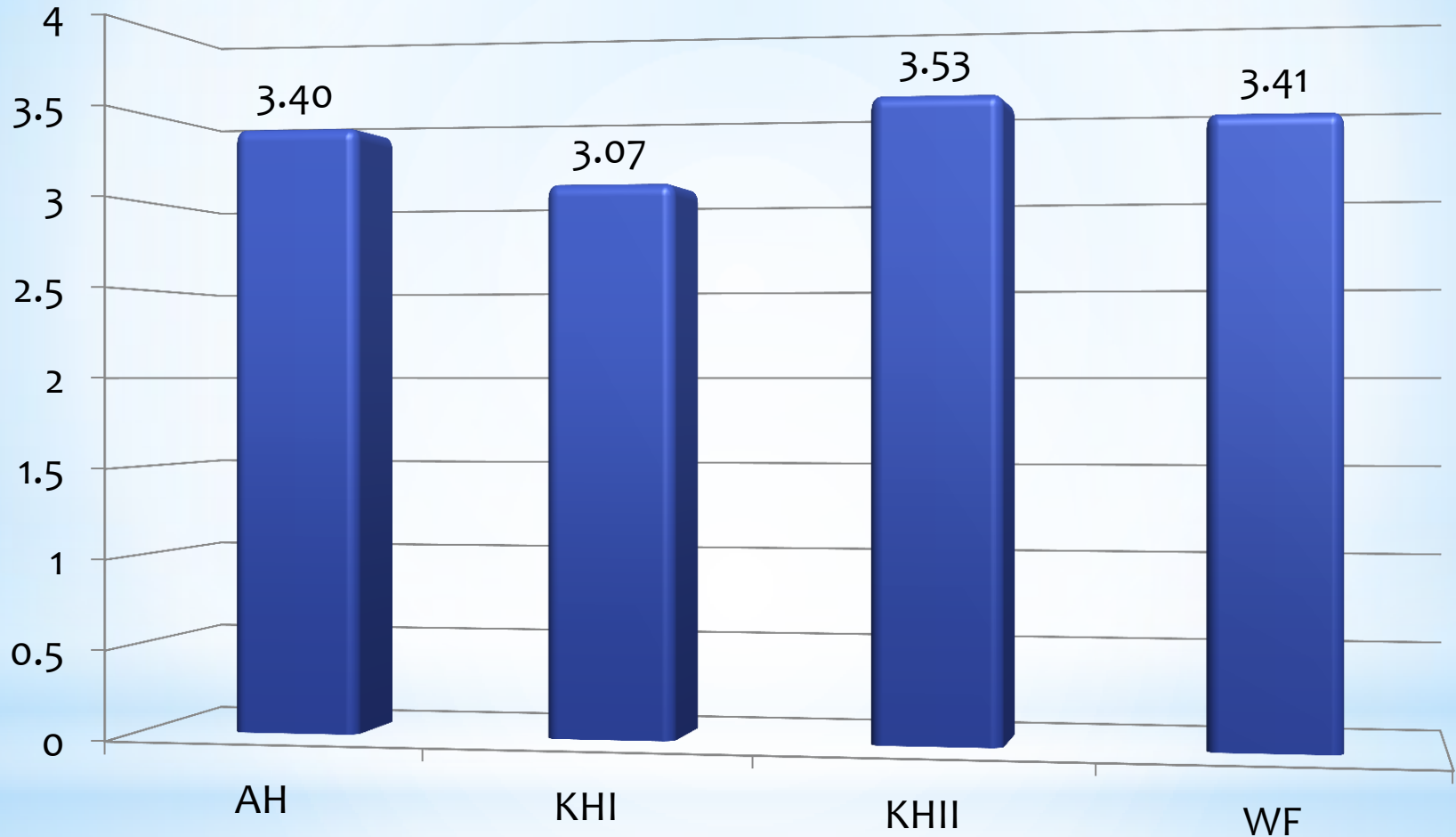

Average Scores By Session



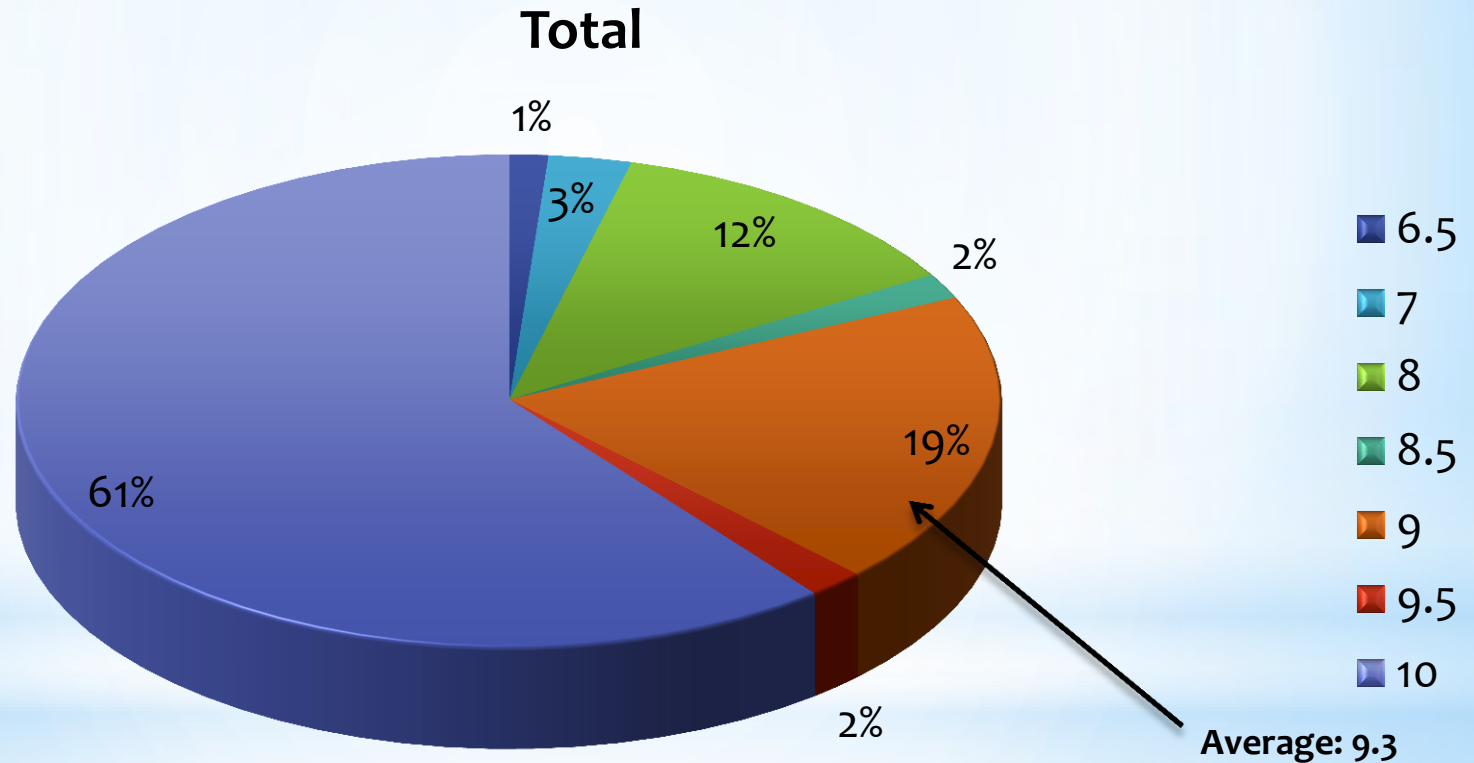
* Young Camper Survey Results

* 85.45% of the campers surveyed felt that they learned “a little” to “a lot” about friendship, independence, teamwork, family citizenship, perceived competence, interest in exploration and responsibility.

- * 57 Campers were interviewed representing approximately 15% of that demographic

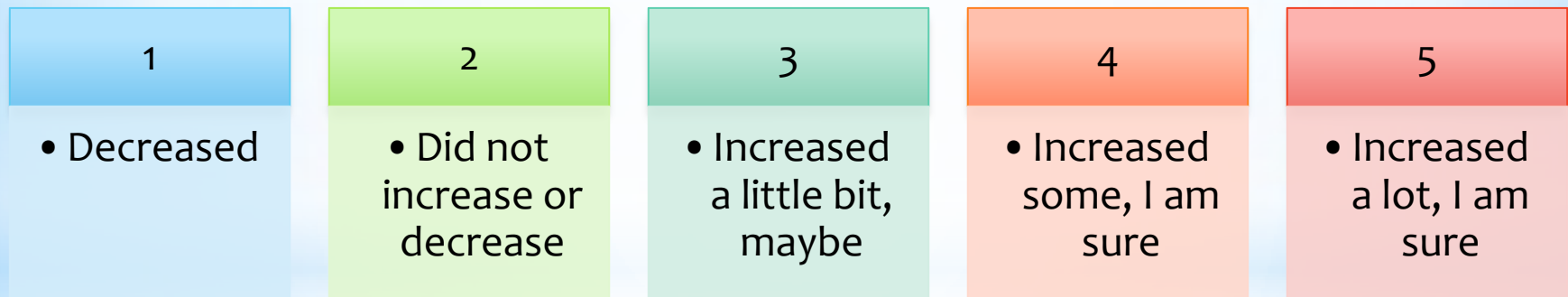

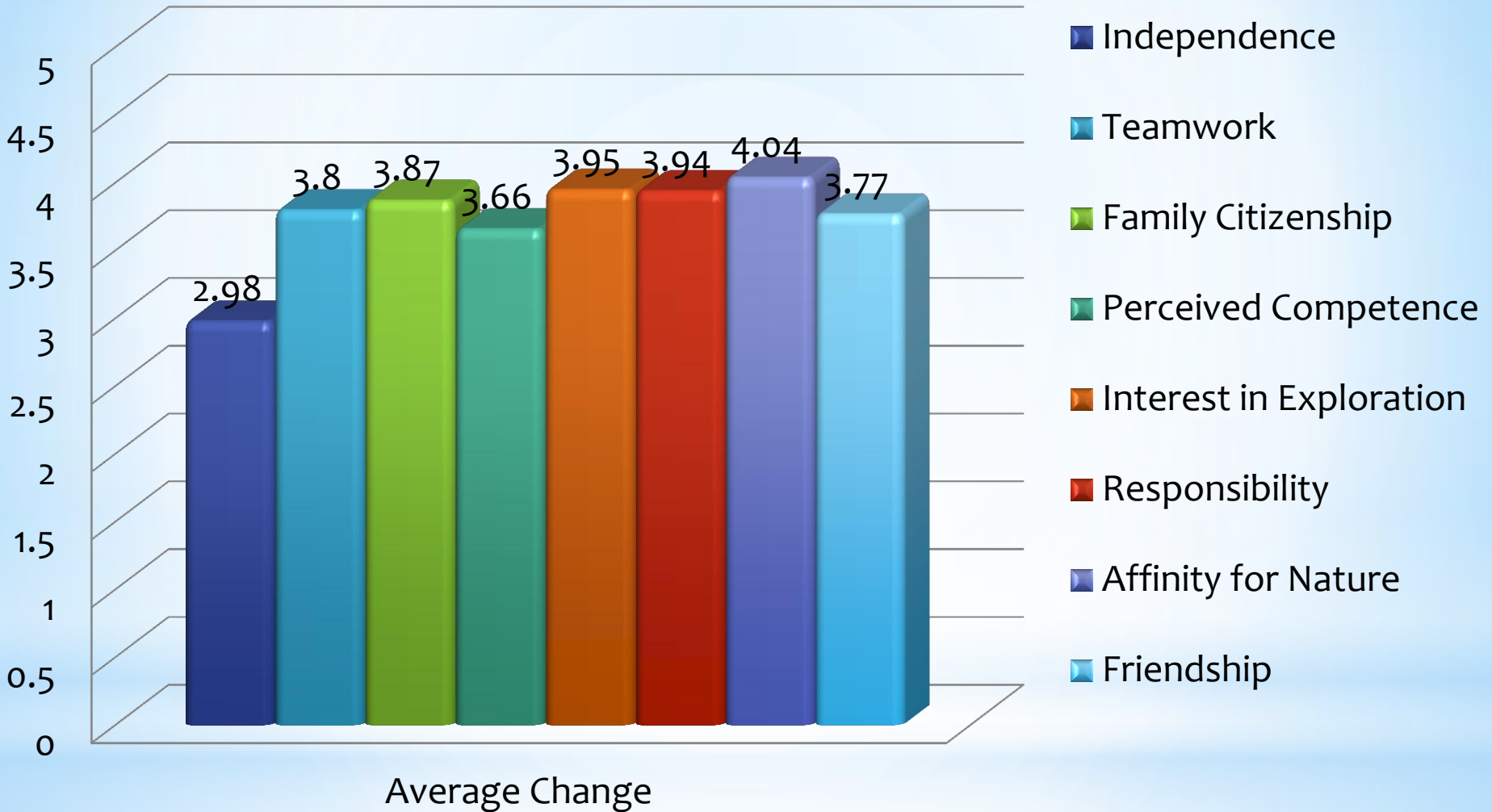

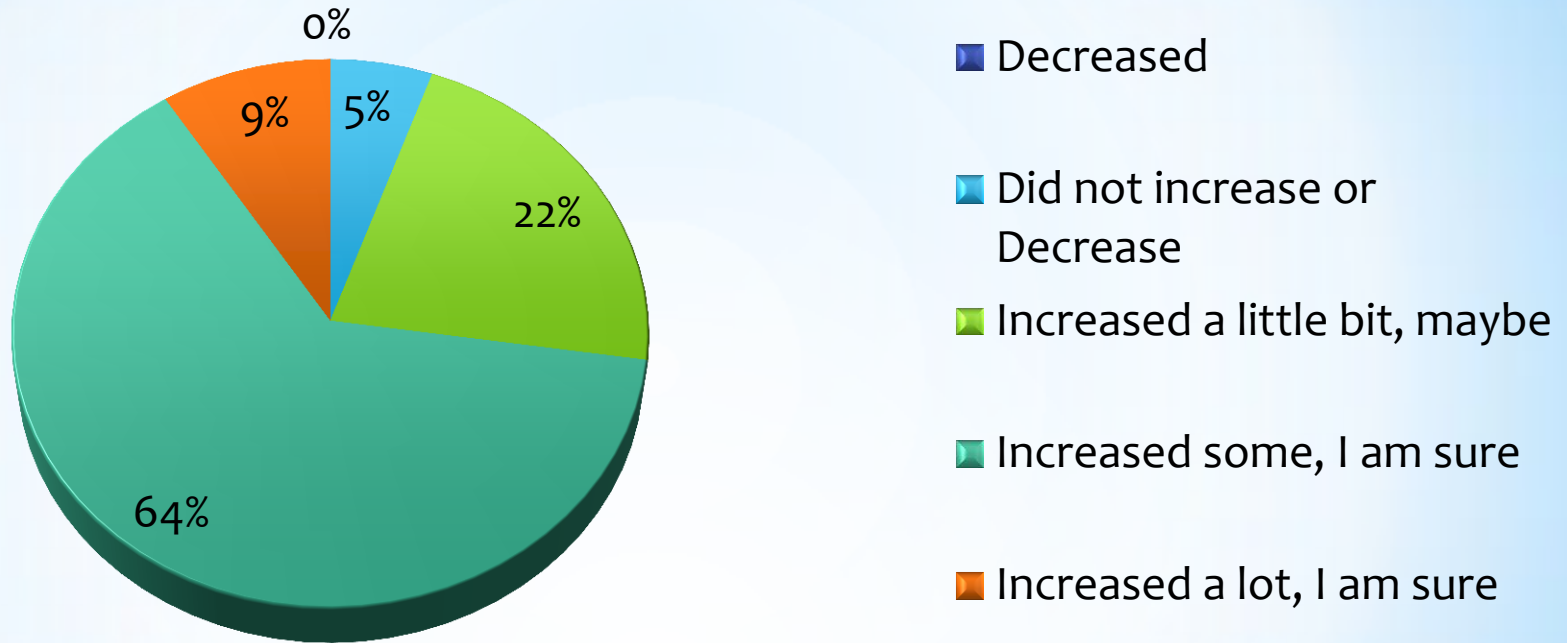

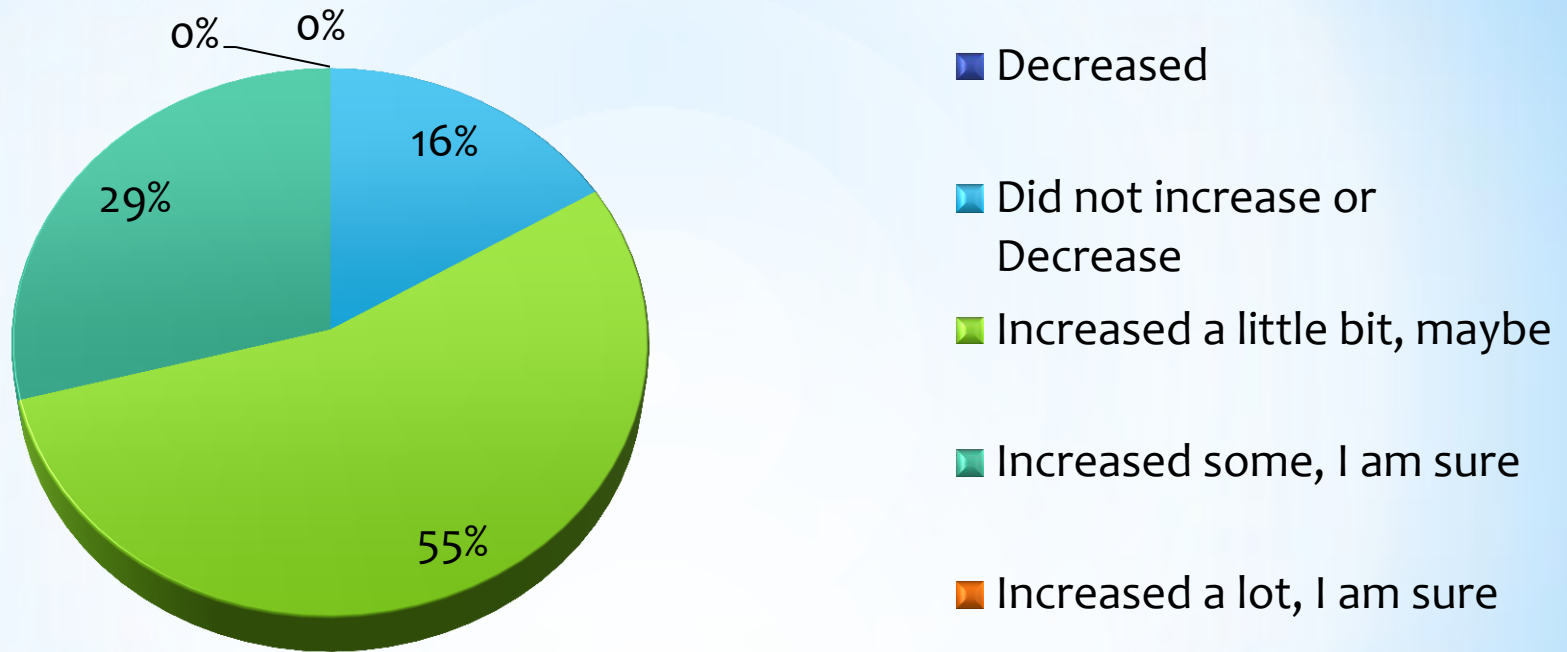


* 95% felt that camp helped increase their friendship skills.

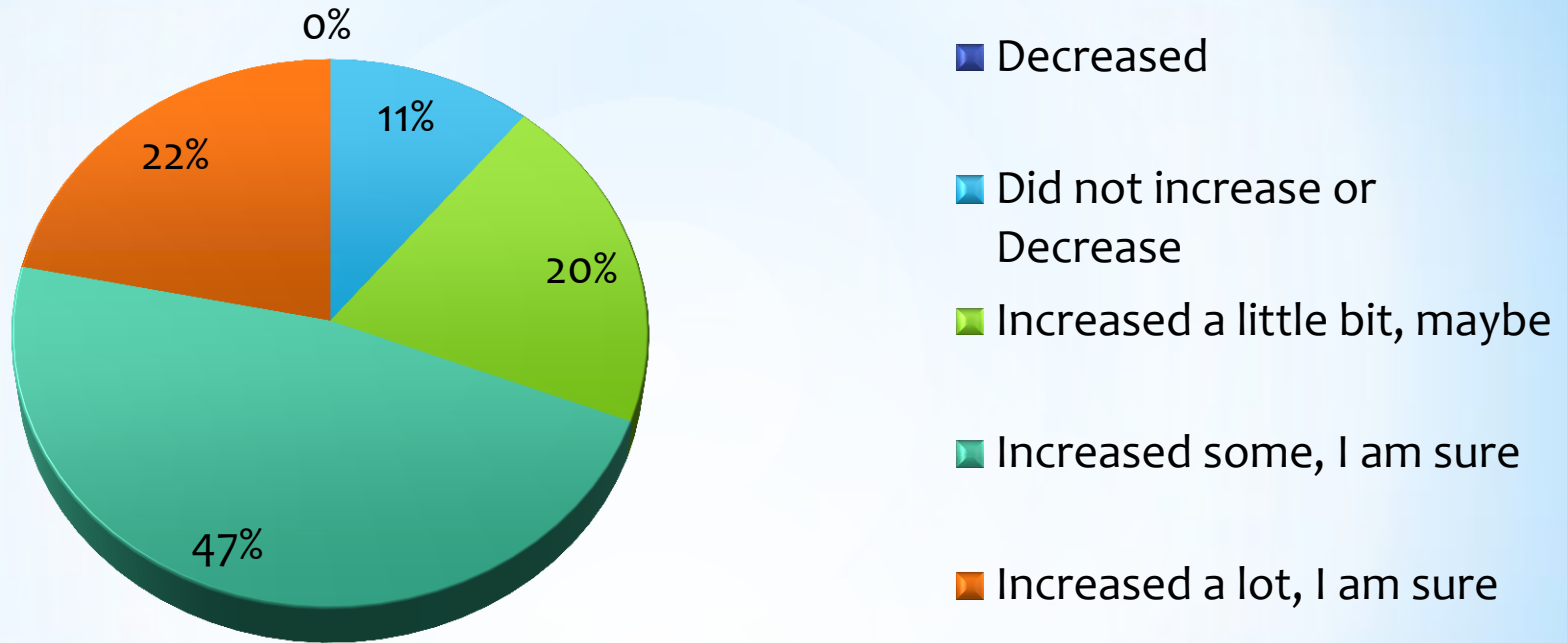
Independence

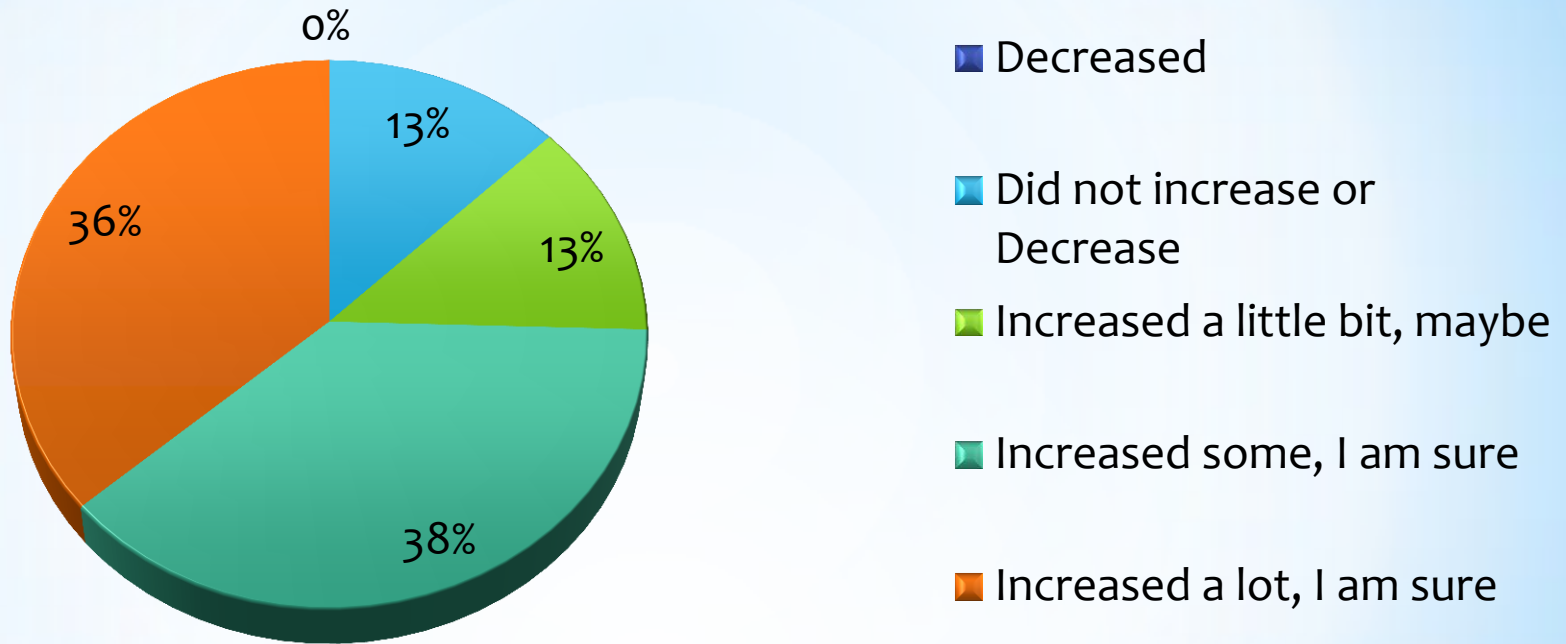
Teamwork

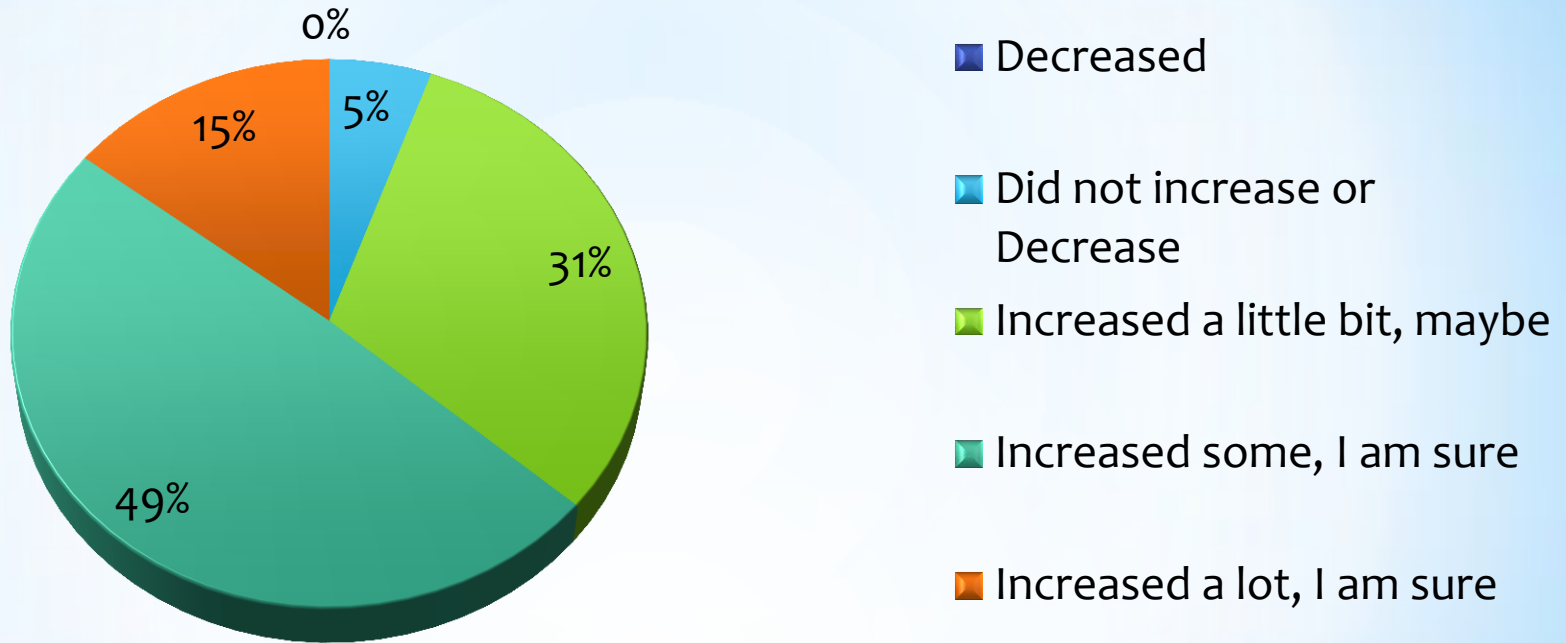
Family Citizenship

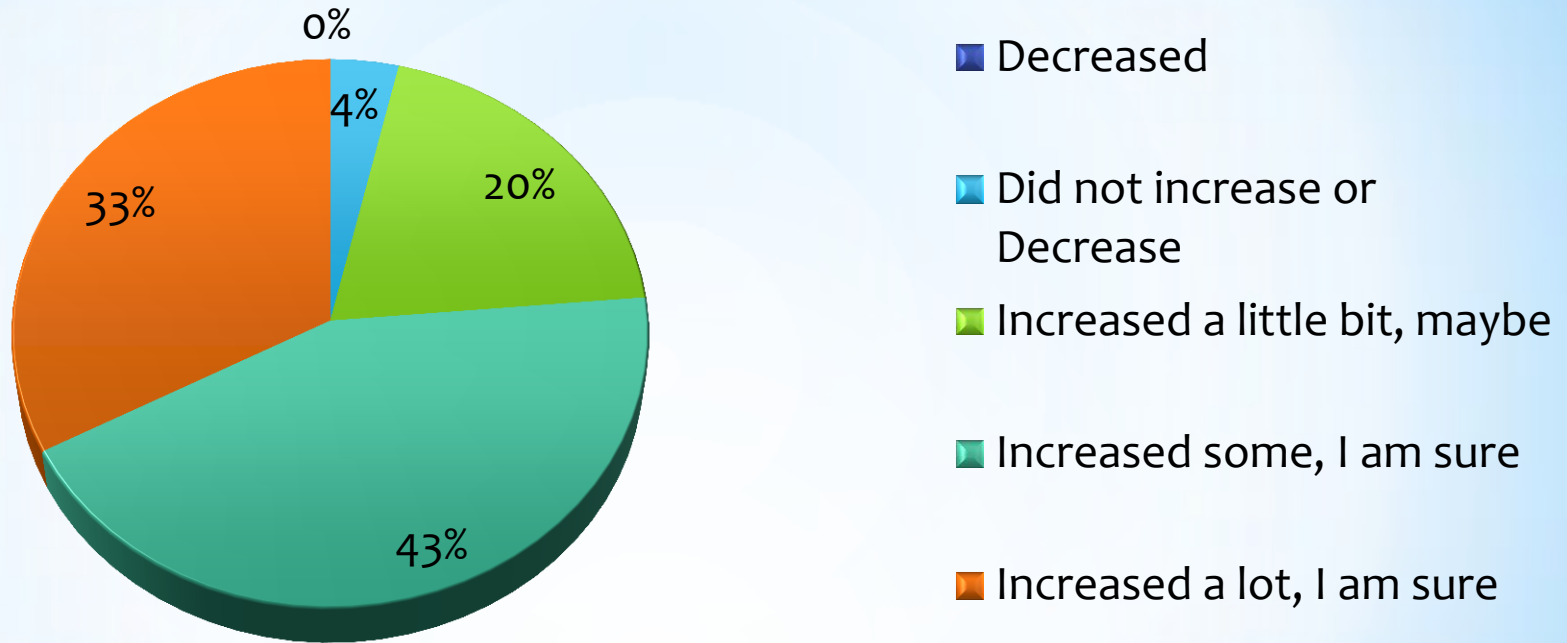


* “Do I feel good about myself doing stuff...”

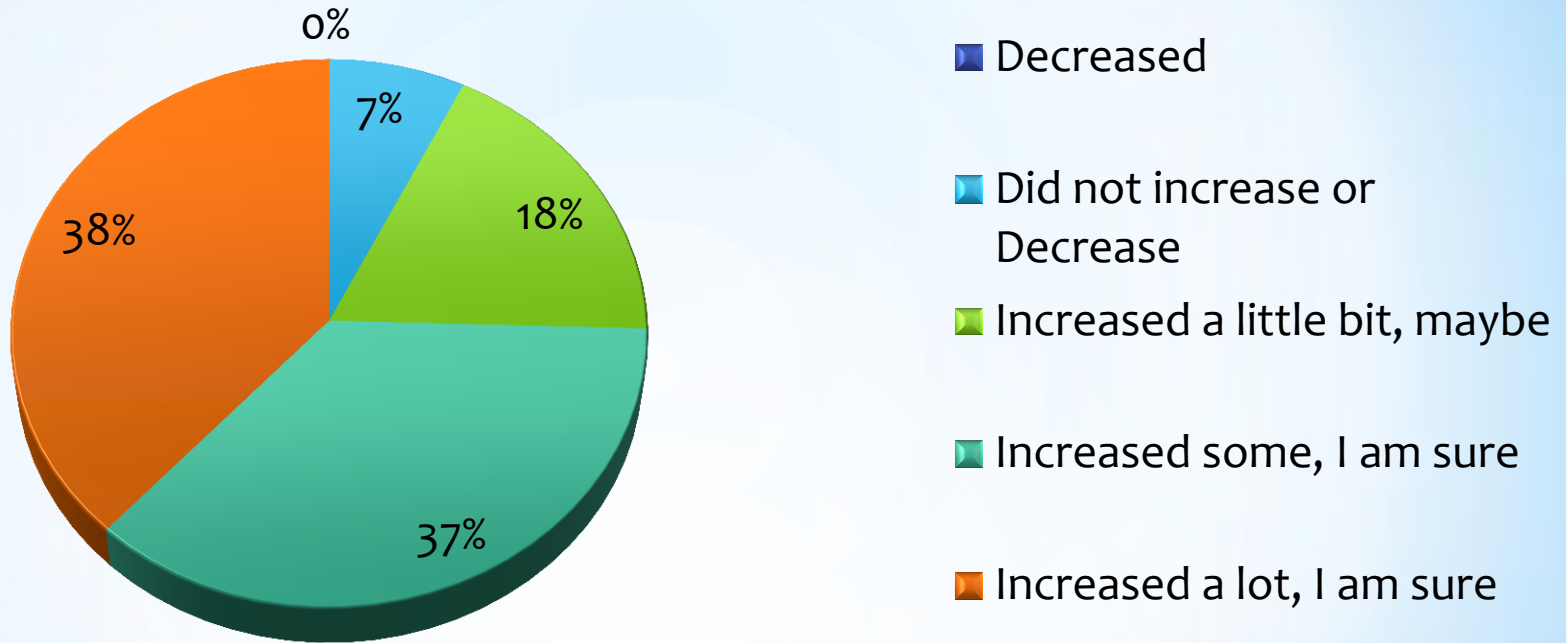
Interest in Exploration

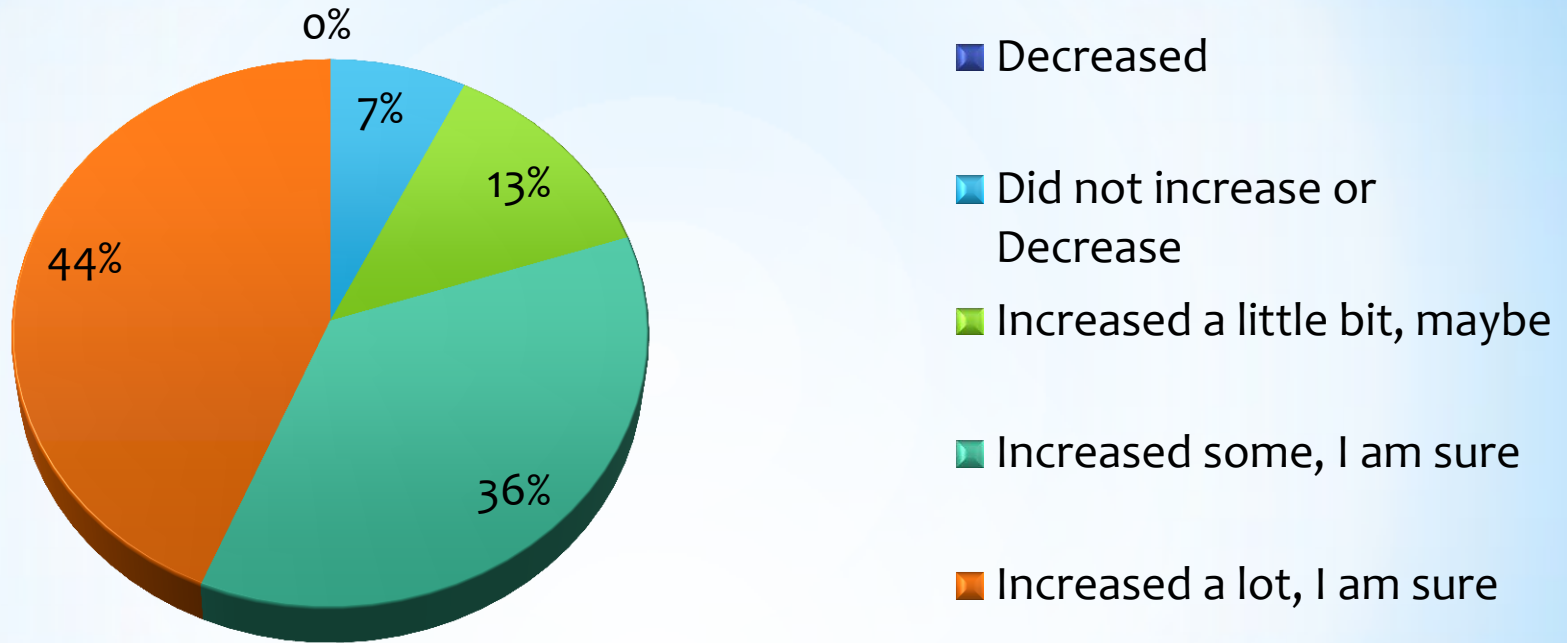
Responsibility

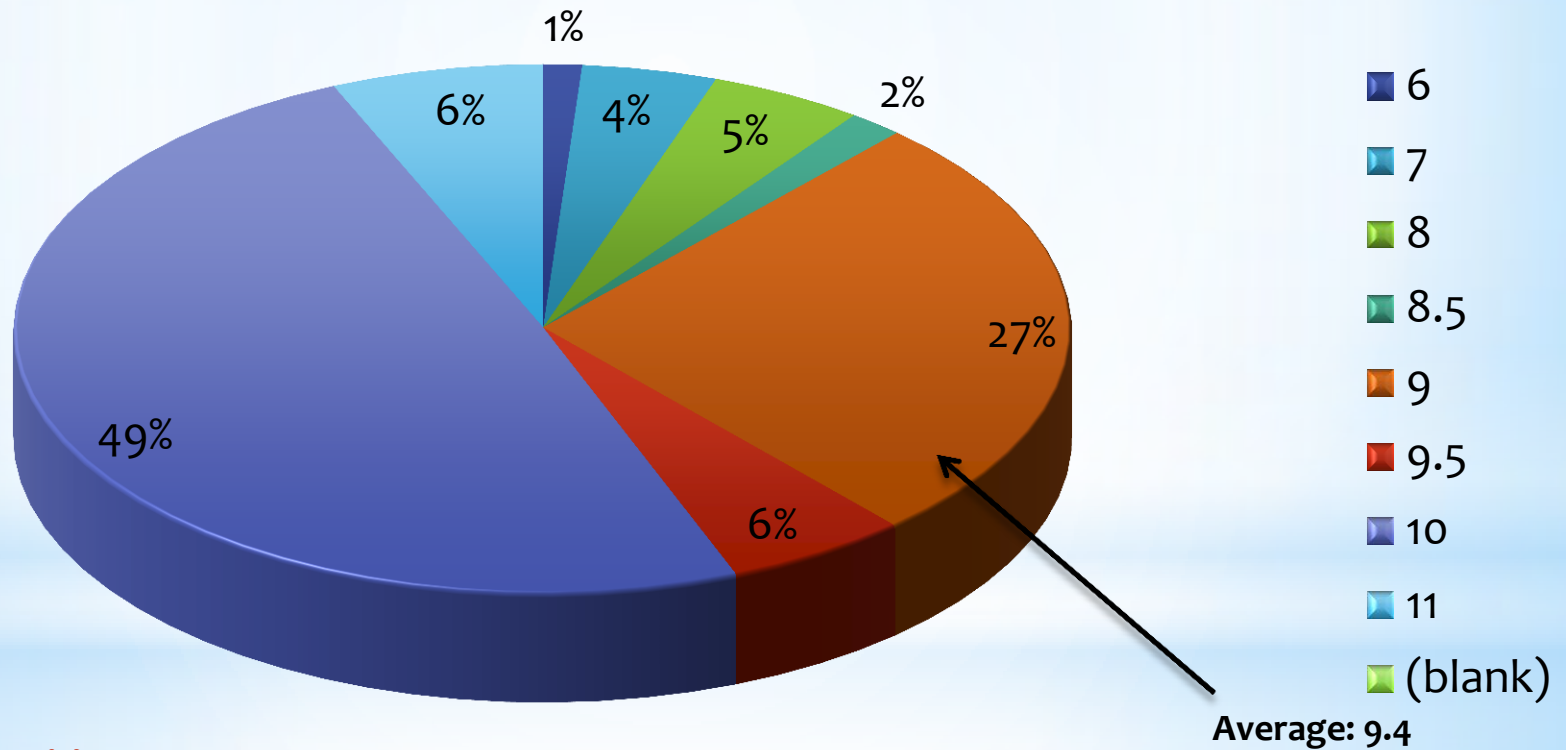


* 93% felt that camp made them enjoy and appreciate nature more than before camp

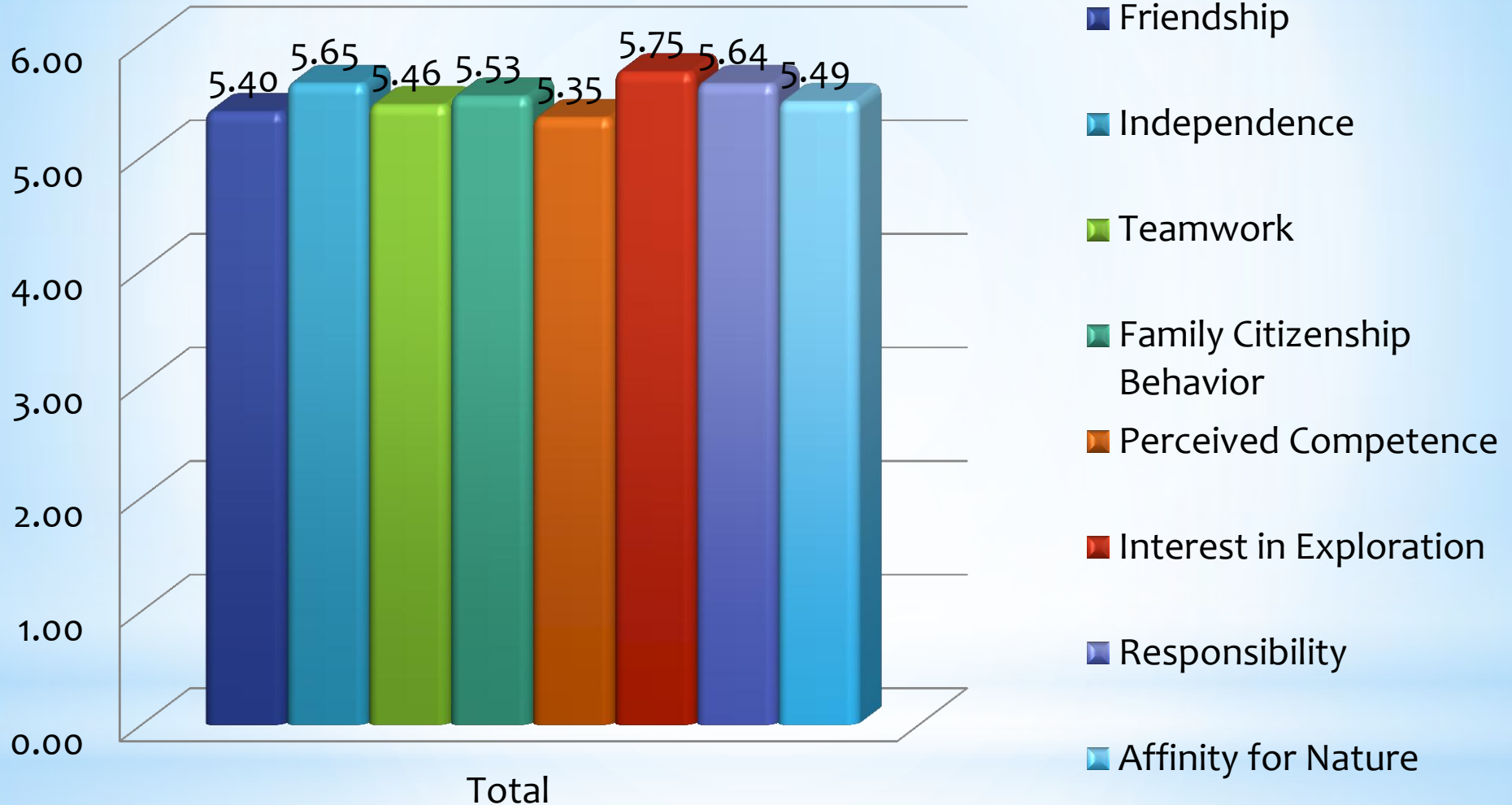

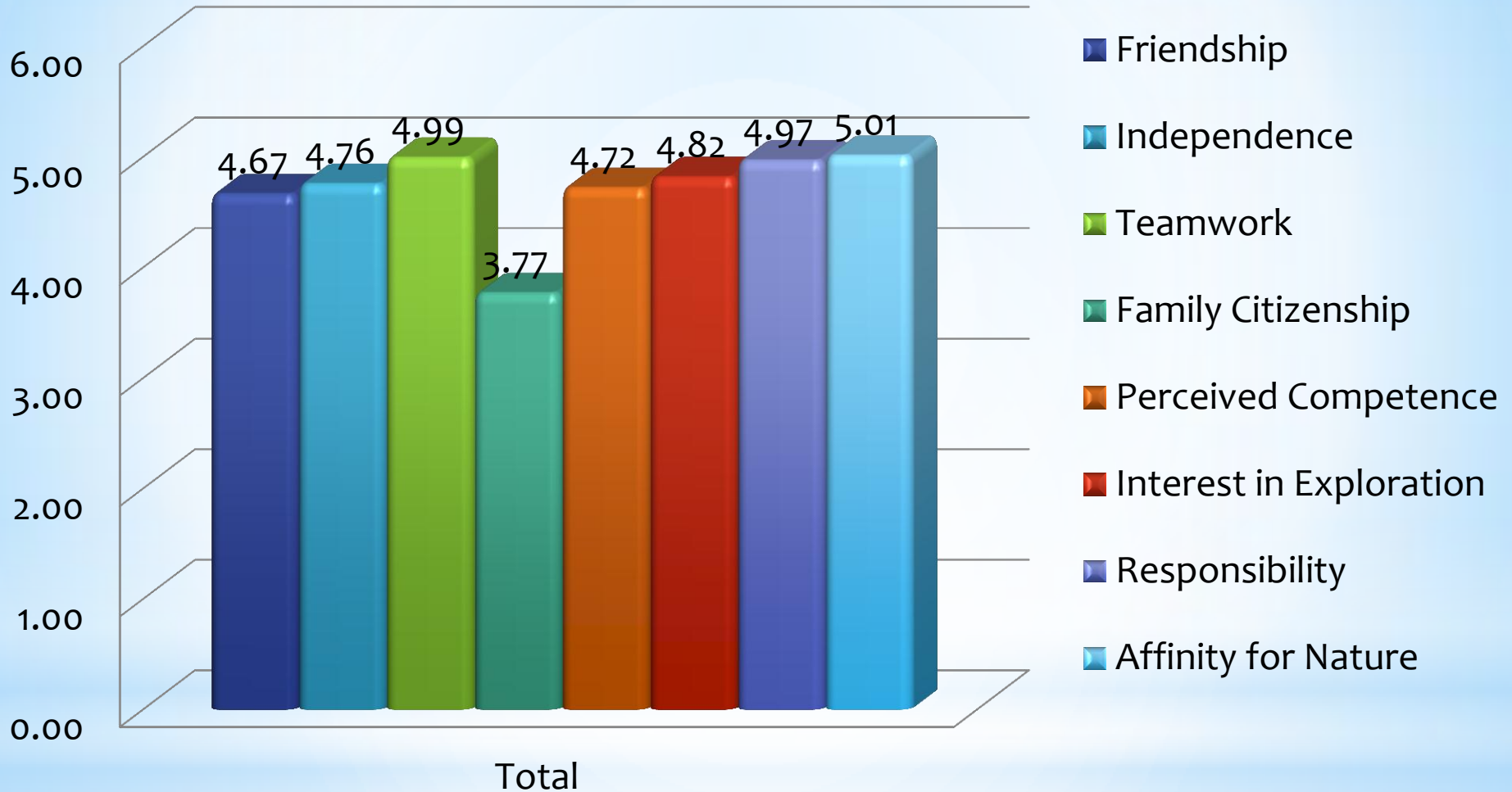

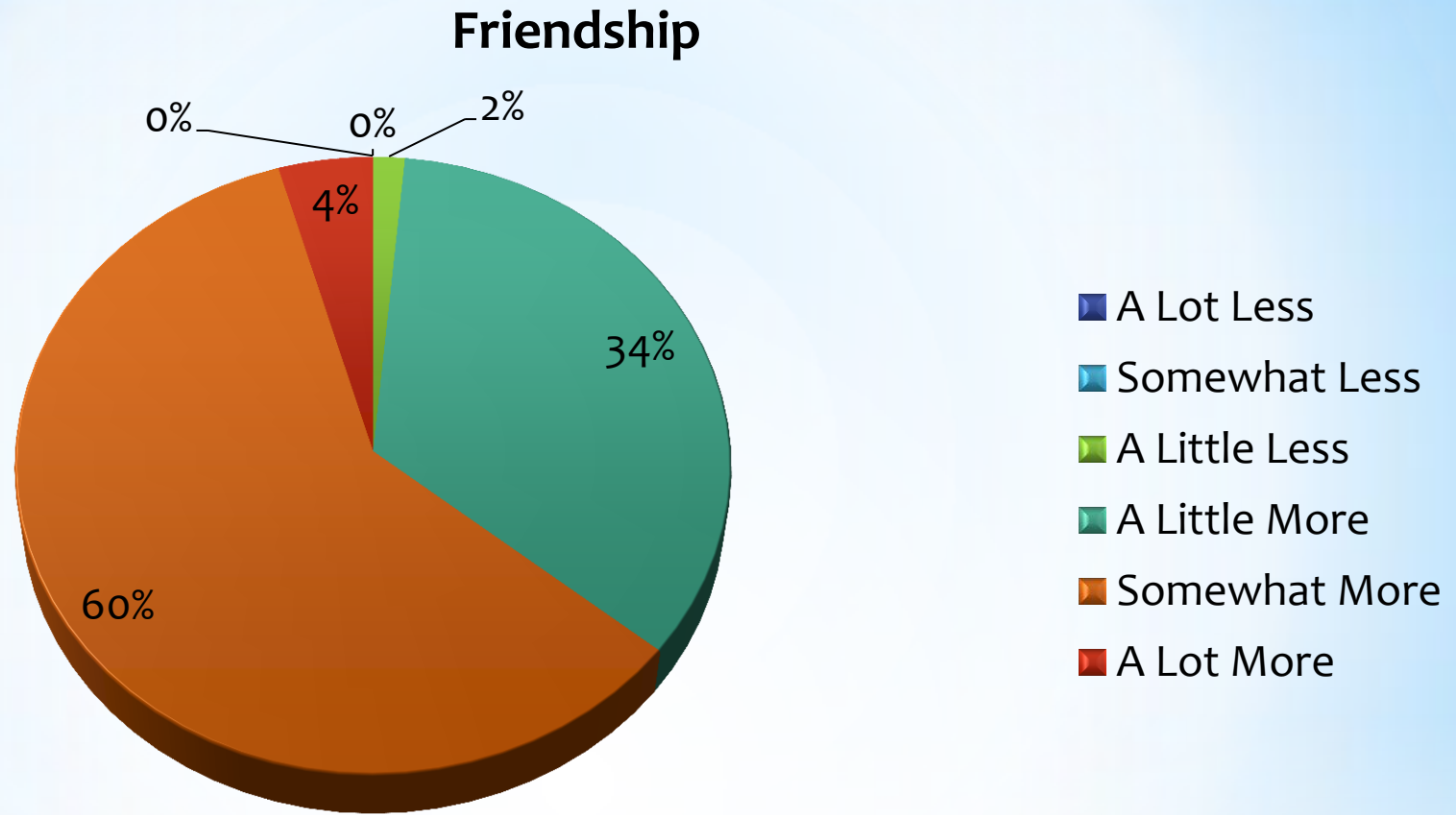
- *“I have good friendship skills” 97%

- *“I am confident” 100%

- *“I am responsible” 100%
- *“I have an affinity for nature” 99%

Average Change by Outcome

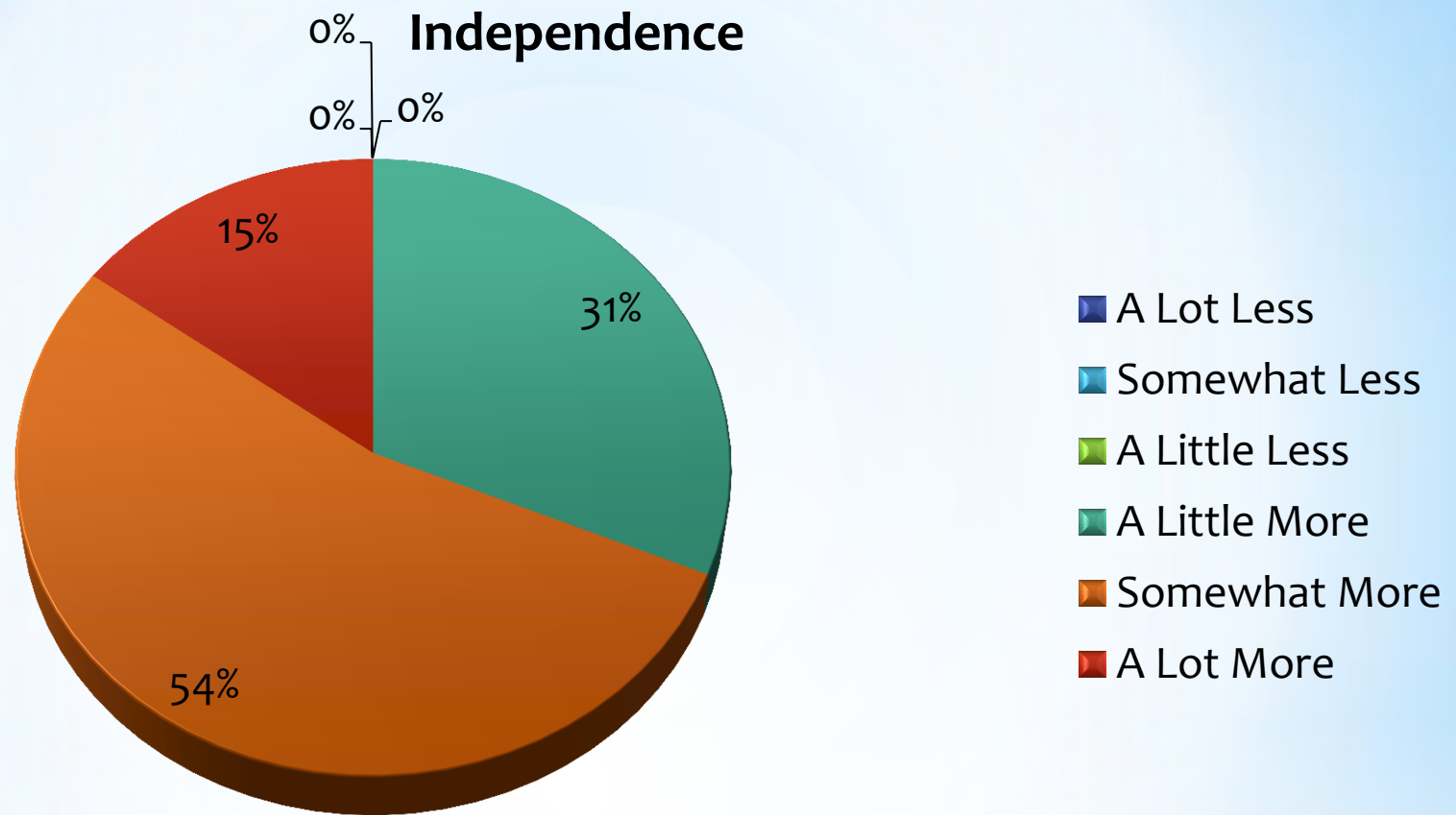

* 64% felt that camp significantly improved their friendship skills

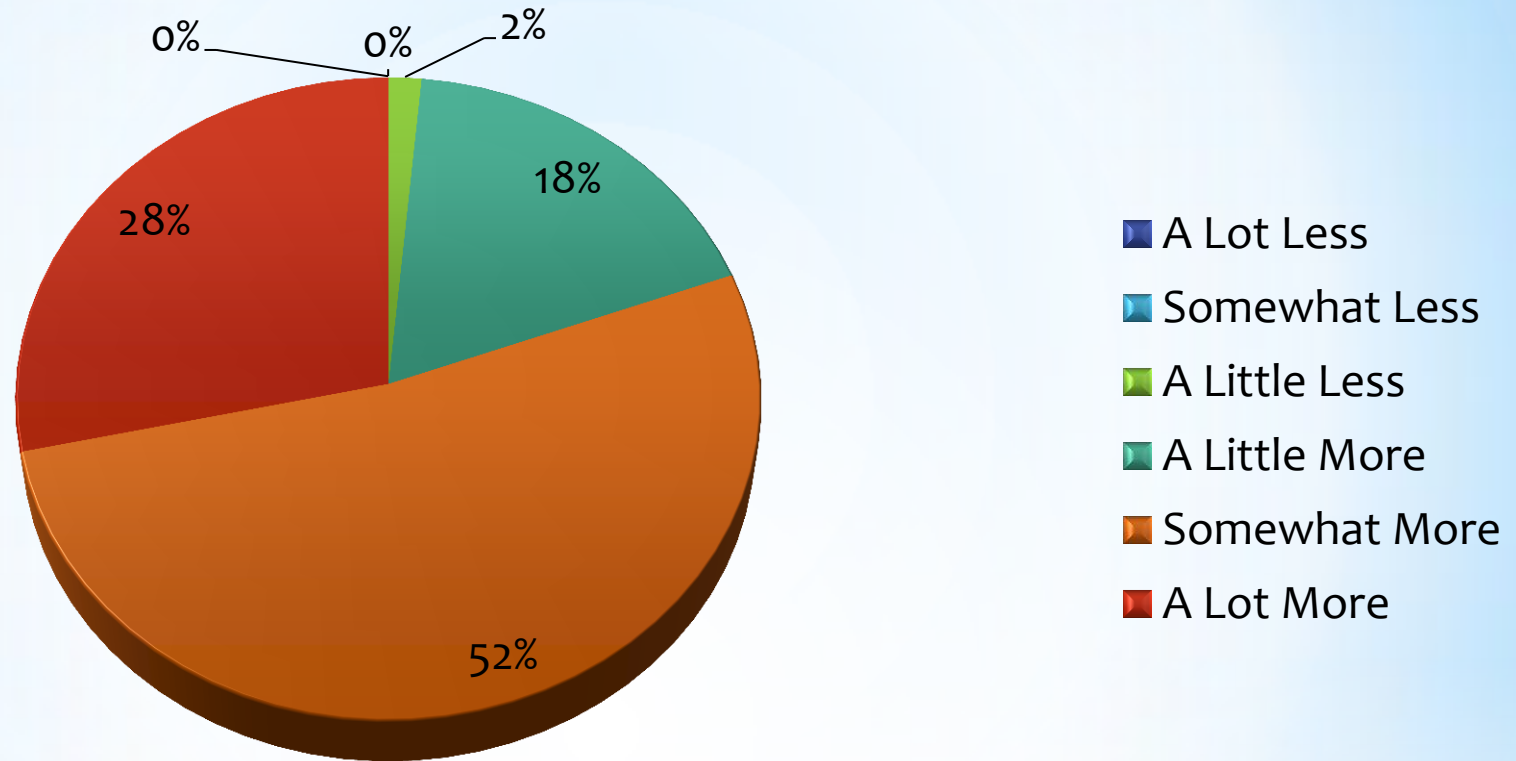

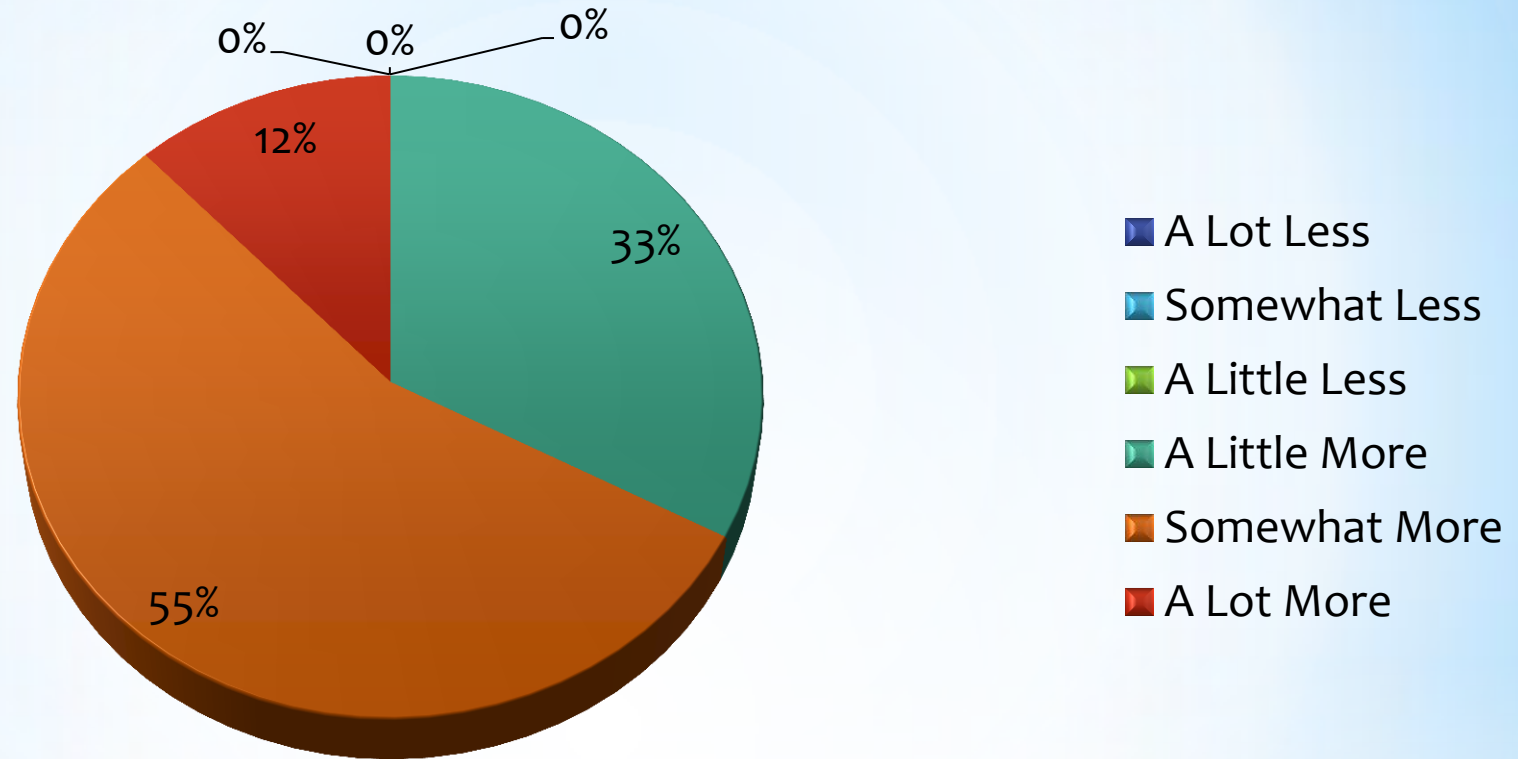
Teamwork

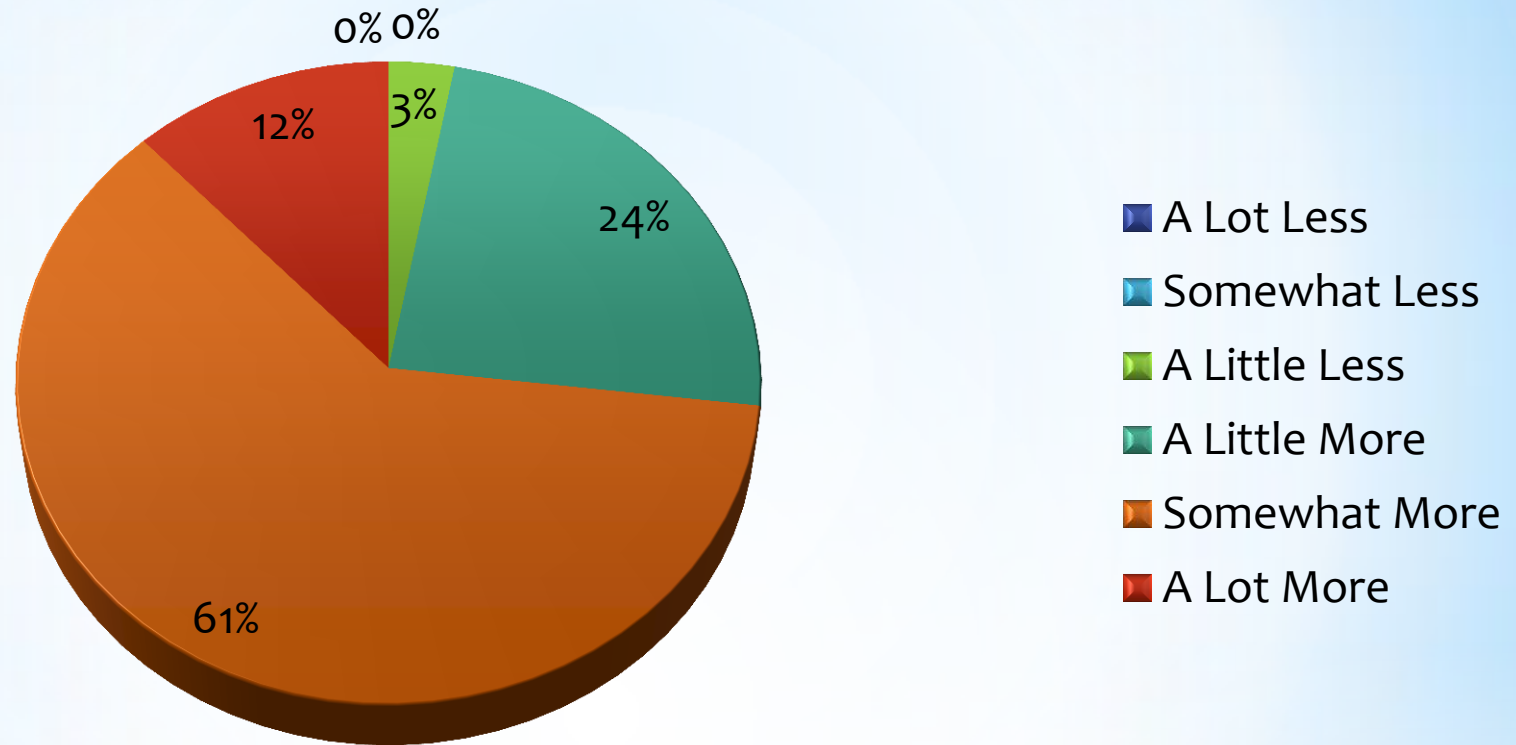
Perceived Competence (Confidence)

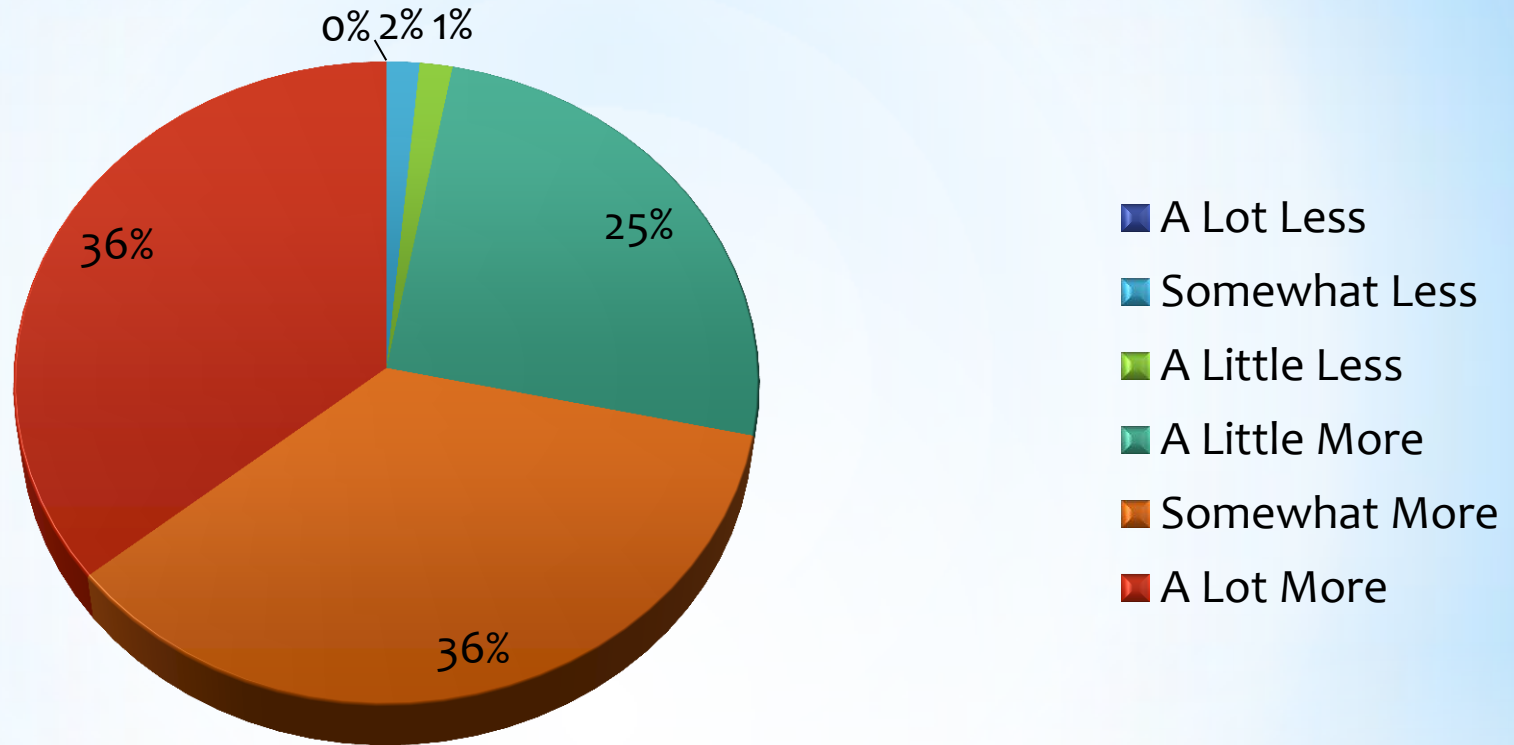
Interest in Exploration (Learning)

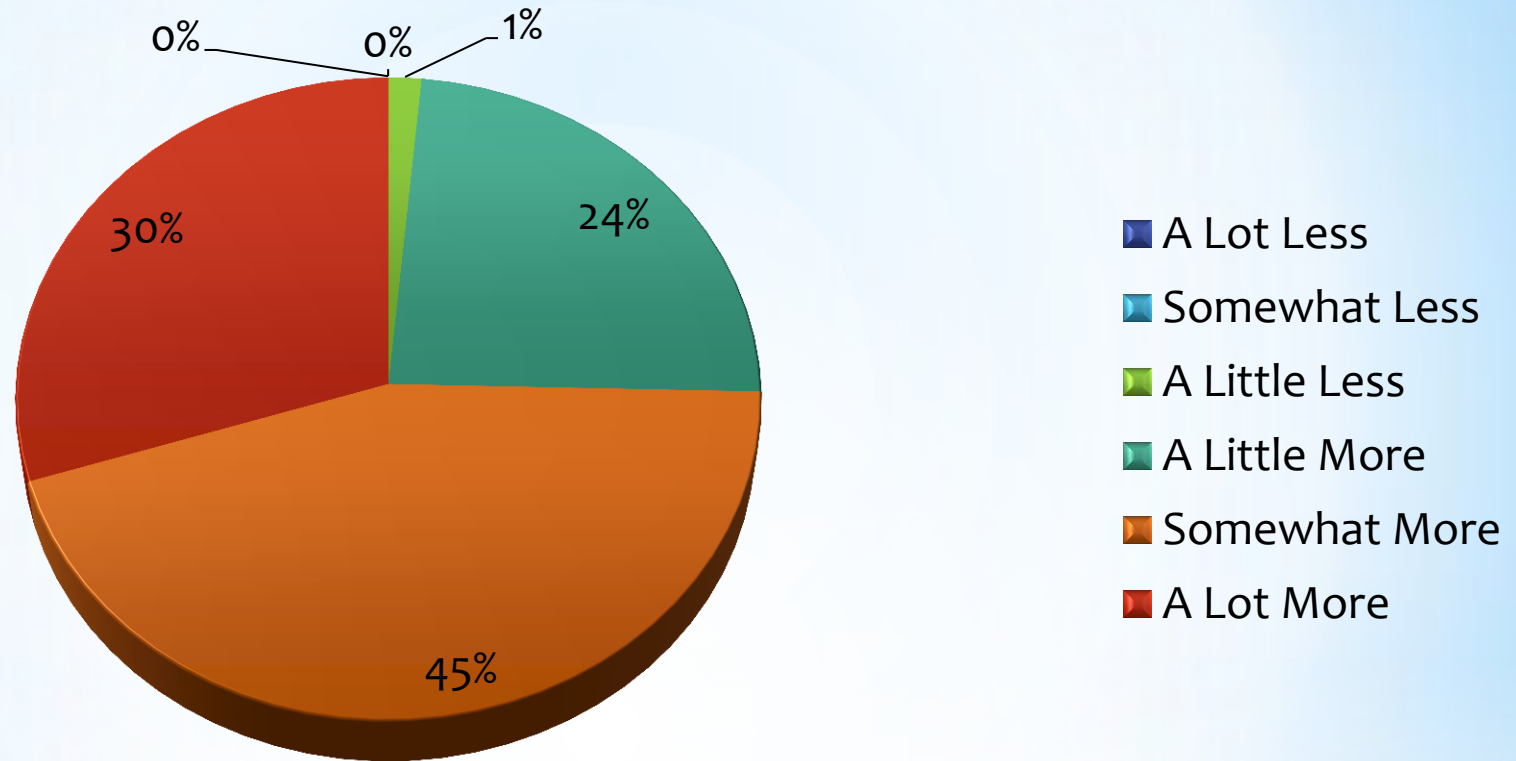
Responsibility

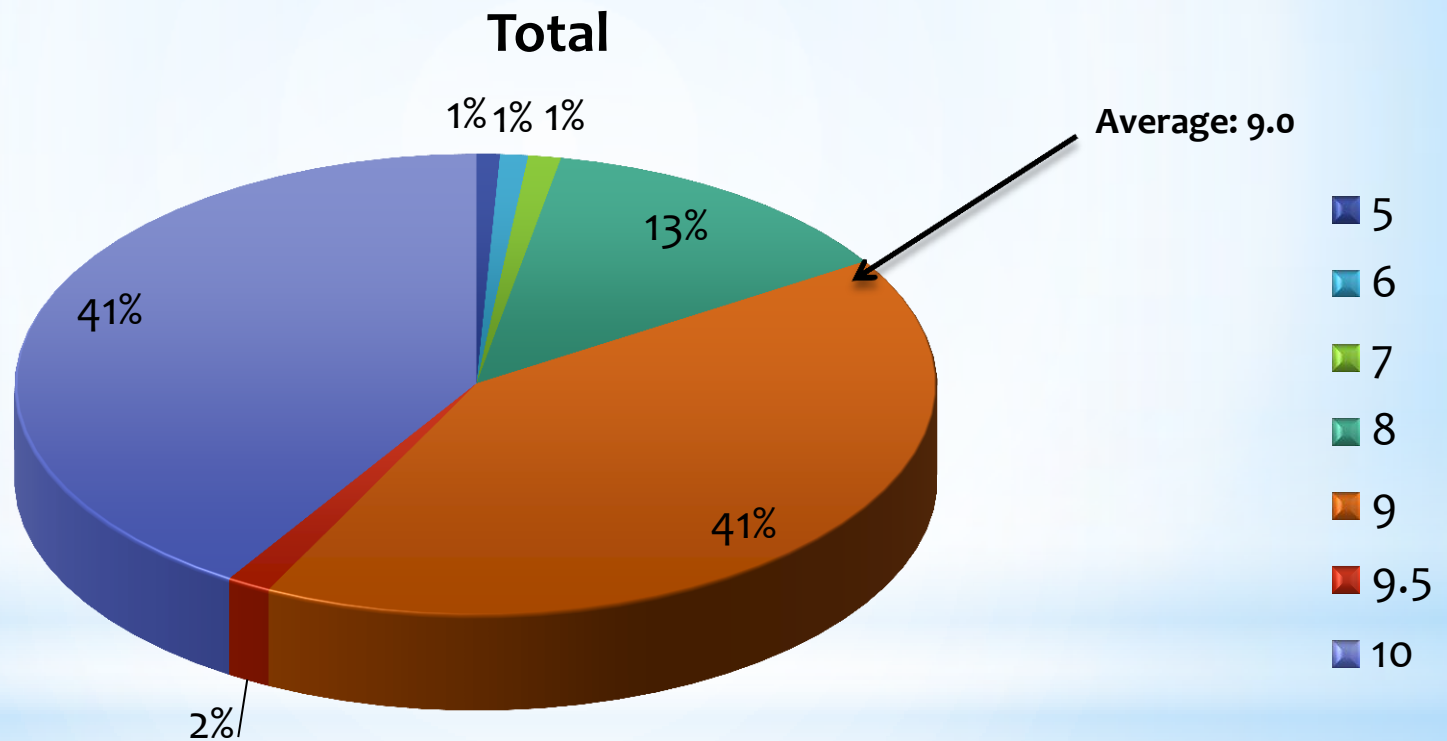
Affinity for Nature
